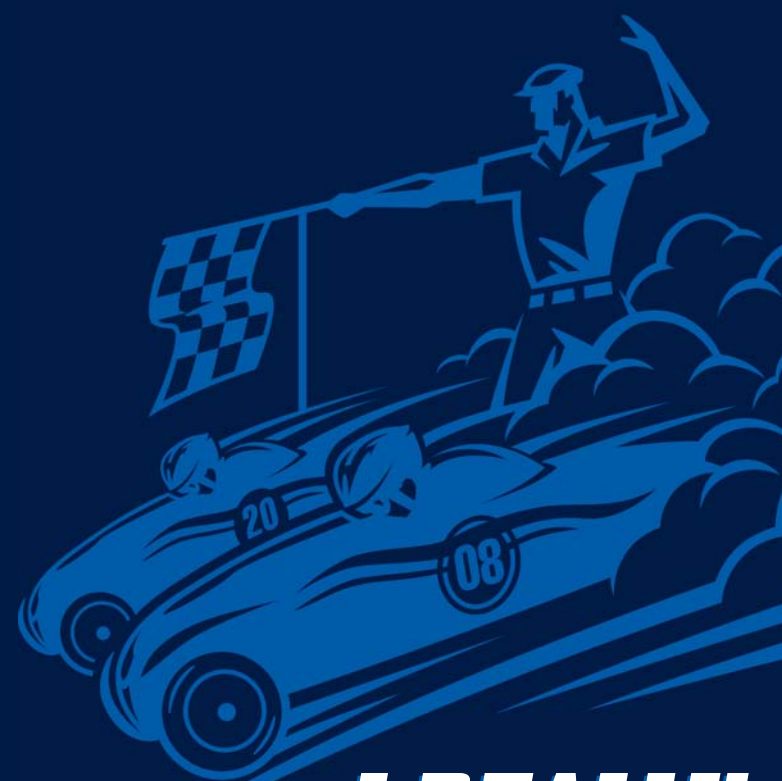

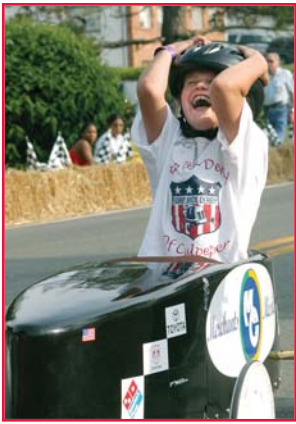

What is the Soap Box Derby?

The Soap Box Derby is a youth racing program which has run nationally since 1934. World Championship finals are held each July at Derby Downs in Akron, Ohio.

The goals of the Soap Box Derby program have not changed since it began in 1934—to promote families working together, to teach children some basic skills of workmanship along with the spirit of competition and the perseverance to continue a project to completion. Across the United States and around the world, family time is spent together building Soap Box Derby cars. Lifelong bonds are developed as the “Derby Experience” is shared from driver to driver, town to town, state to state. The Soap Box Derby is a program that provides cherished memories that will be enjoyed for a lifetime, by kids of all ages.



Benefits of a Dedicated Track and Facility

Year round activities: Many families spend long hours working together for only a couple races each year. With our permanent track, we would be able to provide monthly activities for our young adults and derby families.

Super Kids: This is a race designed for children within the age limits that have special needs and unable to race in the local soap box derby cars. Each car in the Super Kids Derby is dual controlled and driven by an experienced driver and/or a family member.



More rallies: Families develop close ties and relationships, as do the drivers, from the many travels in rally racing. Rallies will be an added activity for our local drivers, while bringing visitors to our area for weekend races. Rallies draw drivers from Ohio, Pennsylvania, Maryland, West Virginia, Washington DC, North Carolina, Florida, and Virginia. Visiting families lodge here for the weekend while racing all day Saturday and Sunday.
